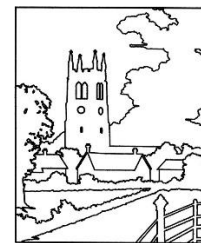

Neighbourhood Plan. A website has been set up by SKDC with regard to the 6-week Village consultation on the proposed Rippingale Neighbourhood Plan, which will influence planning decisions in the future if adopted. The link is <http://www.southkesteven.gov.uk/rippingale>, with necessary instruction and **for comments by Village residents**. Additionally, a physical copy of the submission Plan will be available in the Church for inspection and comment. The consultation will formally begin for 6 weeks on Monday 26 September 2022.

Allotments. The Parish Council administers the Village's allotments, off Station Road. There remain a number of vacant allotment plots available to rent for a reasonable annual charge. There is a thriving Allotment Association who can provide gardening advice and support. If you wish to rent a plot, please contact the Parish Clerk.

SKDC Cost of Living Assistance. SKDC is aware of the issues related to the rising cost of living. In response, it is planning a co-ordinated response to help tackle rising costs. As a first step, it has built a new information bank with a full range of material into the SKDC website. See www.southkesteven.gov.uk/costofliving. SKDC will widen this to help people cope with pressure on domestic budgets, which will intensify as the weather turns colder and heating bills rise. It will work to help residents receive the benefits and other support they are entitled to such as Housing Benefit, Council Tax Support, Discretionary Housing Payments, and Discretionary Council Tax Payments, and by working with stakeholders and voluntary sector partners.

Vacancies for Parish Councillors. There are vacancies for two Parish Councillors by co-option. This role is stimulating and fulfilling. We are seeking volunteers with a wide variety of skills and background. If you are interested in contributing to supporting the Village, and would like greater information, please contact me or the Parish Clerk. To be eligible, you must be over 18 years of age, on the electoral roll and have lived or worked within 3 miles of the Parish for at least 12 months.
